In the past, lodging partners had to manually review Expedia Partner Central to determine if their listings were live or missing content.

The property status capability of the Lodging Supply GraphQL API will enable lodging partners to retrieve the status of Expedia properties, understand content requirements, and get property IDs in real-time.

Functionality

Lodging partners will gain real-time insight into the status of their properties and visibility into missing content requirements.

Goals

1. Go live with new properties faster
2. Reduce call volume to your support teams about questions
3. Provide actionable tools so partners can self-serve
4. Allow partners to maintain visibility into the current state of their listings

Reduce churn

Provide distinct data to lodging partners in real-time, so they're aware of most issues as soon as possible



Increase operational efficiency

Reduce the burden on your support teams by offering data to partners within your connectivity solution

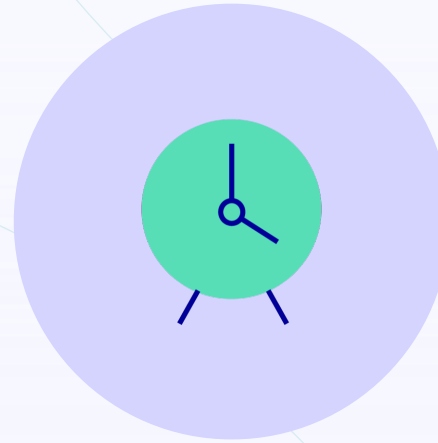


Property status will unlock 3 key benefits for your lodging partners



Improve visibility

Allow lodging partners to understand the status of their properties to resolve issues more quickly and provide focus



Save time

Unlock partners' ability to more easily onboard properties by understanding the status, content requirements, and issues upfront

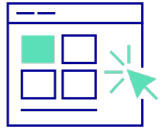


Increase bookings

Allow properties to be booked by travelers faster by understanding issues and statuses as soon as possible

- The Expedia queries may not return complete requirements and continue to evolve
 - As minimum content standards develop over time, it's possible additional content elements may be required
- In order to receive the Expedia checks, you must query using your Expedia ID.
 - In summary, two separate queries must be completed to get the checkpoints for each

- Request property status and IDs
 - Response will include active status on Expedia sites
 - Expedia checkpoints are still a work in progress; it is not recommended to rely 100% on the checkpoints
- Retrieve the URL to review content
 - The URL that is returned is independent of distribution or status of the listing
